#### Course description:

Today hair texturizing goes well beyond layering and stylists are adding mobility to hair by sliding, chipping, point-cutting and notching. And they're using a slew of tools to make those techniques unique. To help you create individualized cuts that will keep clients coming back, this course presents all the essentials of texturizing. Clipper-cutting skills are a must for succeeding in the profitable men's market and are also widely used for precise cutting for ladies. To put you on the fast track, this hair cutting course introduces you to the clipper, its uses and variety of barber-tested techniques. Clipper-over-comb and freehand cutting are demonstrated, and working with hair types is explored in-depth.

- Understand when to use a clipper and when shears might be a better tool for the job.
- Use clippers to create popular fade cuts with tight tapers.
- Employ a clipper-over-comb technique.
- Freehand cut with the clippers.
- Avoid lines, ridges and shadows when creating super-short cuts.
- Cut the popular GI cut with clippers.
- Build business by performing a beard trim.
- Camouflage a man's receding hairline with clipper cutting.
